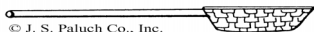

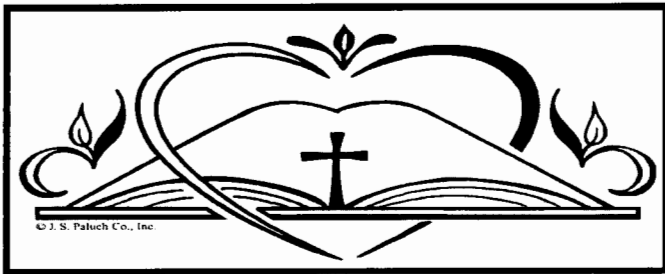

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS:

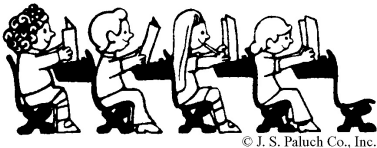

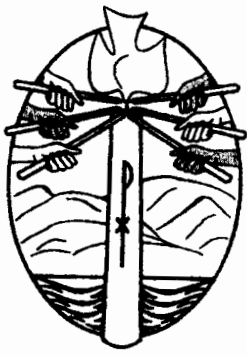

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

It has been nearly a quarter of a century since Christ Our Light Church was dedicated. As we were preparing for the dedication, I remember reading an article comparing the dedication of a church to the initiation of a Christian. The Dedication Rite includes icons of the three Sacraments of Initiation. Sprinkling the church's walls with holy water and anointing them with Chrism recall Baptism and Confirmation. The dedication is completed by celebrating the Eucharist for the first time on the newly consecrated altar – just as newly baptized and confirmed Christians complete their initiation by receiving Holy Communion for the first time.

The similarities between the dedication of a new church and Christian Initiation are no coincidences. They remind us the Church is not a building but is the living, Mystical Body of Christ. Accordingly, it is the responsibility of all of us to be Christ's instruments in bringing new souls into His Body. Saint John Paul II tells us in his encyclical *Redemptoris Missio*: "All Christians share responsibility for missionary activity." The Pope Saint goes on to say: "Individual believers [should] extend the reach of their charity and show concern for those both far and *near*." Missionaries are needed any place, including Navasota, where there are people in whom God's Spirit has stirred interest in Christ and His Church.

Very few of these people come knocking at 510 Manley Street. They have to be led. The only ones who can lead them are you – their relatives, friends, and neighbors. You must be like Saint Andrew. Learning of some Greeks' interest in Jesus, Saint Andrew led them to Him (John 12:21-22). Won't you follow his lead and lead your relatives, friends, and neighbors to the Lord and His Church?

Our parish's Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) process begins **Wednesday, September 13 at 7:00 P. M. in St. Patrick's Hall**. If you know of any people who, even in the most indirect of ways, have expressed interest in the Catholic Faith, don't just invite them to the first RCIA session, *bring* them to it. If you do, like Saint Andrew, you will have played a part, perhaps the most critical in leading souls to the Lord and His Church. Can anyone hope for a greater honor?


